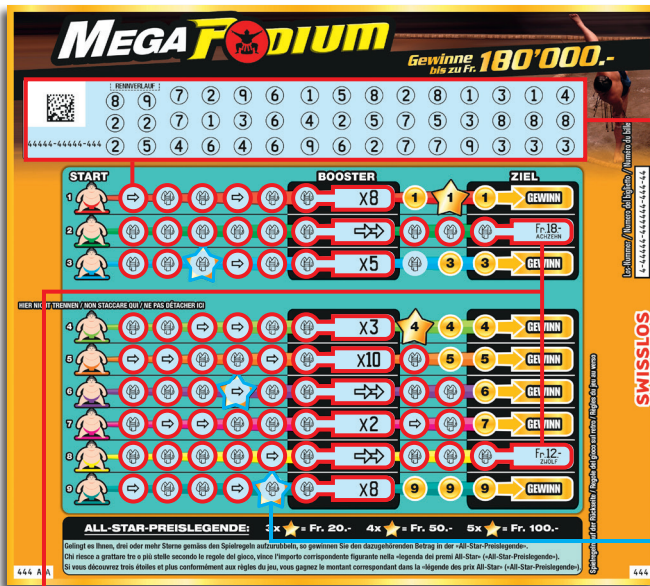

### Rules of Play

Example: Win Fr. 50.- = (3x Star) + Fr. 18.- + Fr. 12.-



- Scratch off one number after the other in the «RACE» («RENNVERLAUF») field.
- Each time you reveal a number, starting from the left («START»), scratch off one game area from the competitor's row with the matching start number.
- If you reveal a ⇨, you can scratch off another game area in the same row.
- If a competitor reaches the «BOOSTER» (six scratched game areas), you can scratch off the «BONUS» field. If you uncover:
  - a double arrow ⇨⇨, you can scratch off two more game areas in the same row.
  - a multiplier (x2, x3, x4, x5, x6, x8, x10), the amount in the «PRIZE» («GEWINN») field of the same row is multiplied by the relevant multiplier.
- Continue as described under 1. to 3.
- If you uncover three or more stars, you win the corresponding amount in the «ALL-STAR PRIZE DISPLAY» («ALL-STAR-Preislegende»).
- If a competitor reaches the «FINISH» («ZIEL») (9 scratched game areas), you win the amount in the corresponding «PRIZE» («GEWINN») field or that amount multiplied by the relevant multiplier (e.g. Fr. 10.- x4 = Fr. 40.-).

#### Notes:

- A player can win up to 5 times on one instant ticket.
- Multipliers have no valid effect for prizes from the «ALL-STAR PRIZE DISPLAY» («ALL-STAR-Preislegende»).
